## FIND YOUR RING SIZE

Finding the perfect ring can be daunting. Use the guide below to easily find the right ring fit for yourself or a loved one.

#### **INSTRUCTIONS**

It's important that your print out is accurate. Make sure all scaling options on your printer

are turned off and select to print the page at "actual size" on a standard A4 page.

## The Paper Sizer- Finger Measurement (Method A)

Use the paper sizer to get an accurate measurement of someone's finger.

- 1. Cut along the outline of the paper sizer.
- 2. Make a small slit in the left end of the sizer.
- 3. Wrap the sizer around the desired finger, with the measurement on the outside.
- 4. Secure by sliding the pointed end through the slit.
- 5. Tighten the sizer at the largest part of the finger.
- 6. Read the measurement and you've got the correct ring size!

### The Circle Chart- Measure a Current Ring (Method B)

This circle chart is the best method to use when buying someone a gift. Sneak a ring from

their jewellery box and use the sizing chart below to determine their ring size (make sure

it's a ring that will be worn on the same finger).


- 1. Find an existing ring that fits.
- 2. Place the ring on the circles below, matching the inside edge to the nearest size.
- 3. If a ring falls between two sizes or is broader always choose the larger size.

#### **IMPORTANT INFORMATION**

- Make sure the ring you use to measure is worn on the same finger
- Consider choosing a ring one size larger than your measurement as your finger swells when hot and should still be easy to slide on and off.
- All sizes listed here are standard South African sizes.
- Keep in mind the average ladies ring size is N and the average men's ring size is V.
- Your ring size will be about  $\frac{1}{2}$  larger on your primary hand (the hand you write with.)


#### **Cutout Section**
